

# Dr Sydney Ibeanusi.

Dr Sydney as popularly called, is a seasoned Trauma and Critical Care Surgeon of repute.

He has background in General Surgery from the Prestigious Royal College of Surgeon Edinburgh, Orthopaedic Surgery from both West African College of Surgeons and National Post Graduate Medical College of Nigeria.

He has advanced post graduate training with a MSc. in Trauma Surgery and Post graduate Diploma in Critical Care from different Top UK Universities.

He has travelled widely in course of training and made wide contacts across the Globe and currently he is a Visiting Scholar to the Prestigious University of Washington Seattle in Trauma and Critical Care.

He is the West African Project Director of the University of Arizona / IVEH Telemedicine Program.

He was part of the Team that set up and has been the lead Trauma Surgeon for the last 7 years at the MSF Trauma Centre at TEME Hospital in Port Harcourt. This is the only dedicated trauma centre in the whole of Nigeria.

He has performed over 5000 cases of complex Trauma reconstructions and has recently performed a re-implantation of a forearm near amputation in Nigeria and another vascularised free fibular graft for complex forearm reconstruction. (Both surgeries are the first recorded in Nigeria and perhaps in the sub-region).

Currently, he serves as the National Focal Point of the UN Decade of Action on Traffic Injury Prevention in Nigeria.

He currently serves as the National Coordinator for the ITCC Project implementation.
